Adjectives with Past and Present Participle Verbs Adjectives are frequently formed by using the past participle (- ed, -t, or -en) and the present participle (-ing) verb forms. Example: The group of children scared the sleeping dog.

Adjectives ! Adjectives modify nouns: I ate a meal. Meal is a noun. We don't know what kind of meal; all we know is that someone ate a meal. I ate an enormous lunch. Lunch is the noun, and enormous is an adjective that modifies it. It tells us WHAT KIND OF meal the person ate.

The changes in form. English adjectives change only when used to compare while French adjectives have to agree with the word they are describing according to its gender and quantity. The placement in a sentence. French adjectives are usually placed AFTER the noun, while English adjectives come BEFORE it.
